Who can apply?

Values Statement

The Values Statement of Christian Community International

1. Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. (Matthew 22:37)

A.- Devotional Life

Now this is the eternal life: That they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent (John 17:3).

This is what the Lord says: "Let not the wise man boast of his wisdom or the strong man boast of his strength or the rich man boast of his riches, but let him who boasts, boast about this: that he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord, who exercises kindness, justice and righteousness on earth, for in these things I delight" (Jeremiah 9:23-24).

B.- Ministering to the Lord

Be an example, actively participating in worship and praise in the meetings.

In the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers...while they were worshiping the Lord and fasting... (Acts 13:1-2).

"Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks." (John 4:23).

C.- Aggressive Faith

From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven has been forcefully advancing, and forceful men lay hold of it (Matthew 11:12).

"If you can?" Jesus said. "Everything is possible for him who believes" (Mark 9:23).

Then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. (Romans 10:17).

D.- Identity

...to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness (Ephesians 4:23-24).

...and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator (Colossians 3:10).

For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he...(Proverbs 23:7).

E.- Complete Integrity

Lord, who may dwell in your sanctuary? Who may live on your holy hill? He whose walk is blameless and who does what is righteous, who speaks the truth from his heart and has no slander on his tongue, who does his neighbour no wrong and casts no slur on his fellowman (Psalm 15:1-3).

F.- Stewardship

"...Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this" says the Lord Almighty "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it" (Malachi 3:10).

G.- Fear of the Lord

2. Love your neighbour as yourself. (Matthew 22:37)

A.- Be Identified with the Body (in a local church)

From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work (Ephesians 4:16)

For her stones are dear to your servants (Psalm 102: 14).

B.- Have a Servant's Heart

But if your servant says to you, I do not want to leave you, because he loves you and your family and is well off with you (Deuteronomy 15:16).

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death - even death on a cross! (Philippians 2:5-8).

C.- Mercy

"He does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him" (Psalm 103:10-11).

Because judgment without mercy will be shown to everyone who has not been merciful. Mercy triumphs over judgment! (James 2:13).

D.- Resolving Conflicts

If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over (Matthew 18:15).

If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone (Romans 12:18).

Make a word pact that you will give a good report of your brother and be submissive to Matthew 18 in conflict situations.

E.- Do Not Judge

Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you (Matthew 7:1-2).

Cain's Path – (Genesis 4)

F.- Restoration

Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted. Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfil the law of Christ (Galatians 6:1-2).

G.- Faithfulness

My eyes will be on the faithful in the land (Psalm 101:6).

Who then is the faithful and the wise servant, whom the master has put in charge of the servants in his household to give them their food at the proper time? (Matthew 24:45).

Whoever can be trusted with very little... (Luke 16:10).

...but to show that they can be fully trusted... (Titus 2:10).

H.- Loyalty

...And not to steal from them, but to show that they can be fully trusted, so that in every way they will make the teaching about God our Savoir attractive (Titus 2:10).

Loyalty must be shown towards God, delegated leadership and authorities.

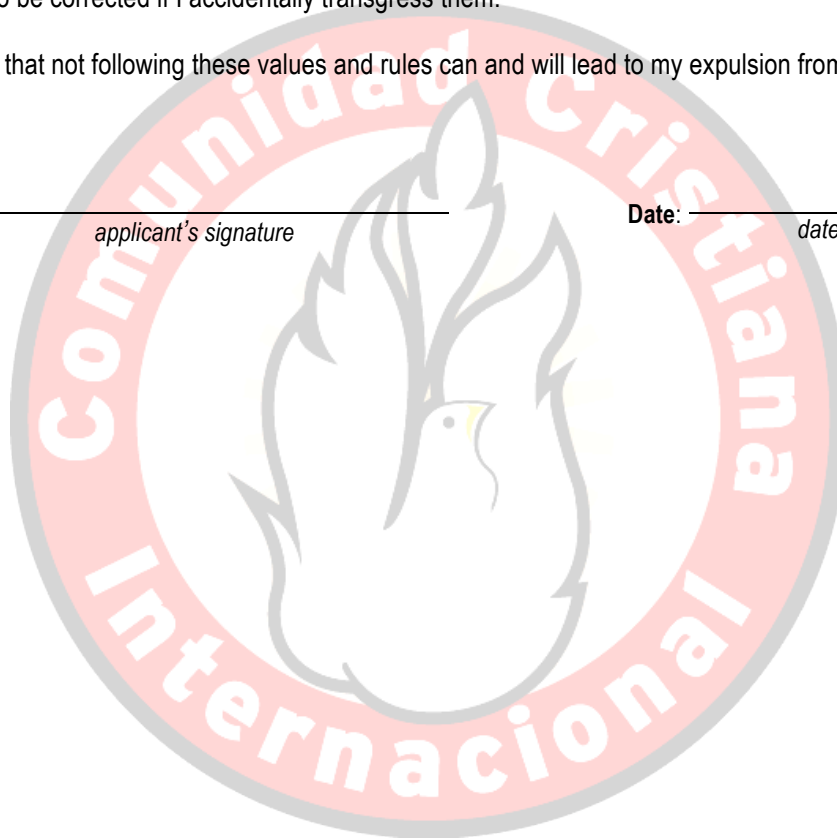

Visa Information

You can attend Master Builder on a tourist visa. MB is not registered as an official school but is part of the church work. We advice you not to mention words like "study", "course" or "school" when entering the country since this will make the immigration agents think you need a student visa. Just saying that you are visiting some friends in a church in Monterrey or something similar often makes the situation easier. Keep it as simple as possible.

Arrival and Departure dates

Master Builder runs from March 16th to April 5th 2010.

You must arrive by March 15th. Classes start on March 16th.

Last day of classes is April 5th. You may return home on April 6th (not earlier).
